BASIC INFO

We are a POLYNESIAN dance group, so all dancers will learn at least 3 different islands throughout the dance season. Practices are imperative to your learning and excelling in dance. If you are unable to attend practice, please text Auntie Ruta. We have 3 main performances we practice for: our Annual Christmas Showcase, our Final Recital, and a Festival. Although we practice as we're getting ready for a performance, you are NOT REQUIRED to perform in any performance. We'd love you to perform because it's a beautiful way to showcase what you've learned in class throughout your dance journey and to take pride in your hard work, but again, it is not required.

WHAT TO BRING TO PRACTICE?

Girls: An ie lavalava, pareu, or sarong is required for 'Ori Tahiti and Siva Samoa, and a pa'u skirt is required for hula. All three islands will be taught throughout the dance season.

Boys: An ie lavalava is required for Siva Samoa, and shorts are to be worn for 'Ori Tahiti and hula.

Each level of dance has a different color, so for 'Ori Tahiti girls please wear your level of color pareu/sarong. You can purchase and ie, a sarong/pareu from Walmart, Amazon, Etsy, Aloha Hula, California Hula Supply, or Aloha outlet. Shirts should be black or any color of Natia shirt. Jeans, denim, skirts, and dresses are not permitted. Having your hair tied back or in a bun is strongly preferred.

ARE PARENTS, CHILDREN/GUESTS ALLOWED TO COME INSIDE?

Only paid registered students may enter the studio. Parents, drop-off and pickup only. Parents and guests can occasionally view practices, but the invitation will be shared on our social media platforms. Parents may enter the last 5 minutes of practice to pick up their dancer only if they are 10 years old and younger.
